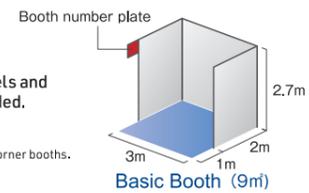
## EXHIBIT GUIDELINE

### ◆ Booth

#### 1) Basic Booth

As shown on the right, back and side panels and booth number plate are going to be provided.

\*Carpet is not going to be provided.  
\*Panels are not going to be provided for island booths.  
\*Panels are not going to be provided on aisle-sides for corner booths.

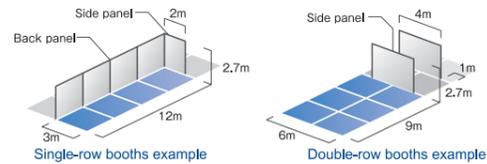


#### 2) Layout Type

3 types are available:

● Single-row ● Double-row (Available for 4 booths or more)

● Island (Available for 12 booths or more) \*1 - 3 booths will be planned as a single-row booth.



#### 3) Booth Allocation

The organizer decides booth allocation taking exhibits, booth size, demonstration plans, dates of application, etc. into consideration.

### ◆ Application

#### 1) ① Submit your application form (see attached document):

Fill in, sign, and seal the application form, and send it to the RISCON TOKYO Management Office.

#### ② Apply on the Official Website: \*Japanese language only

No need to submit the original copy of your signed and sealed application form. You can complete the whole process from application to contract execution on the exhibition's official website. Please see the website for further information.

\*The e-mail address of the person who approves your participation as an exhibitor is required besides the contact person's one.

#### 2) Deadline

**May 29 (Fri.), 2026** Application will be closed prior to the deadline once all booth spaces are booked.

#### 3) Withholding & Revocation

In case the organizer judges the exhibit is unsuitable for this exhibition, it may withhold or revoke the application.

### ◆ Fee

#### 1) Exhibit Space Fee

**Basic Booth : JPY 435,600** (Tax included) / 1 unit booth\*  
\*1 unit booth = 9m<sup>2</sup> (WDH : 3m×3m×2.7m)

#### 2) Corner Booth Reservation

A corner booth can be reserved with additional fee.  
**JPY 165,000** (Tax included)  
\*Fee is the same regardless of the number of booths applied.  
\*A corner booth is going to be provided for four or more booth space in principle without this reservation fee.  
\*Without corner booth reservation, location will be allotted based on the booth size, date of application, etc.

#### 3) Included in Exhibit Space Fee

- Exhibit space, back panels, side panels, and booth number plate
- Show invitation \*Quantity is determined by booth size.
- Operation and promotion of the exhibition by the organizer
- Exposure through exhibitors list on official website and handouts
- Safety management and security guard fees by the organizer

#### 4) NOT Included in Exhibit Space Fee

- Decoration, construction, and operation fee of exhibitor's own booth
- Construction fee and any other charge of electricity, water, gas, etc. for exhibitor's own booth
- Fee of advertisement on official website etc.
- Damage insurance on exhibits, etc.
- Expense for injuries arising during exhibition, demonstration or transporting of exhibits, etc.
- Expense for renovating booth decoration, structure, etc. required by regulations and exhibition rules.
- Other expense not listed on "3) Included in Exhibit Space Fee"

#### 5) Payment

After acceptance of application, the organizer will issue an invoice to the applicant.

**Payment Deadline : June 30 (Tue.), 2026**

\*Cash remittance in Japanese Yen only

\*Bank charge is to be paid by the applicant along with exhibit space fee.  
(Chargeable JPY 10,000 for each bank remittance.)

#### 6) Cancellation

Once an application is accepted, withdrawal is not allowed in principle. If the organizer deems it legitimate, the application may be withdrawn with cancellation fee as below.

Date of Cancellation (Acceptance of Written Notice)	Cancellation Fee
On / Before June 30 (Tue.), 2026	50% of Total Exhibit Space Fee including tax.
On / After July 1 (Wed.), 2026	100% of Total Exhibit Space Fee including tax.

- Possible to invite visitors interested in your products and technology and explain details in a closed private room. Suitable for sales agents workshops too.

- Attract visitors' attention from the special stage.

Outline : Guaranteed Linking Period : Jul., 2026 - Jan., 2027 (7months)  
\*The banner will be shown after payment.  
\*The advertisement page (the main page of the official website) recorded 153,000 page views last year.

#### ② Floor Map

Fee : JPY 165,000 (Tax Included)  
Outline : Distributed to ALL visitors for free.  
20,000 copies (expected)

#### ③ Combo (Banner ① & Floor Map ②)

Fee : JPY 275,000 (Tax Included)  
Outline : Terms of use and posting method are the same as Banner ① and Floor Map ②

#### ④ e-Newsletter

Fee : JPY 165,000 (Tax Included)  
Outline : Within 200 letters in Japanese or 35 words in English  
Schedule is determined by the Management Office (Sep., 2026)  
Accounts : Approx. 50,000 (expected)

#### ⑤ Digital Signage Advertisement

Fee : Type A : JPY 275,000 (Tax Included)  
Type B : JPY 165,000 (Tax Included)  
Outline : Type A monitors are for exclusive use by a single company. Type B monitors are for joint use by two companies.  
The signage will be installed near the RISCON entrance gate.  
Vertical monitors ranging in size from 42 to 46 inches are used to display advertisements.

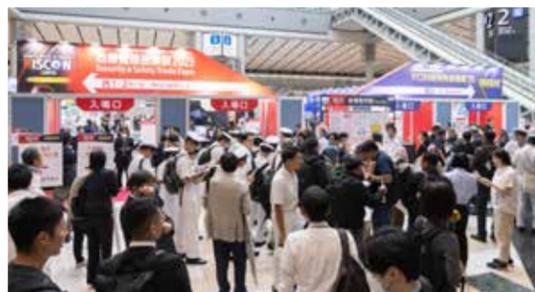

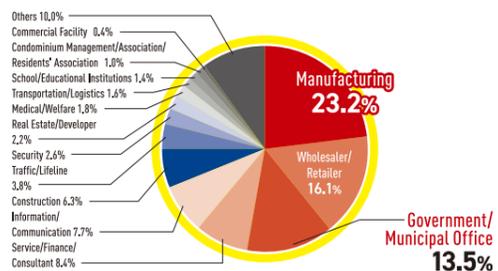

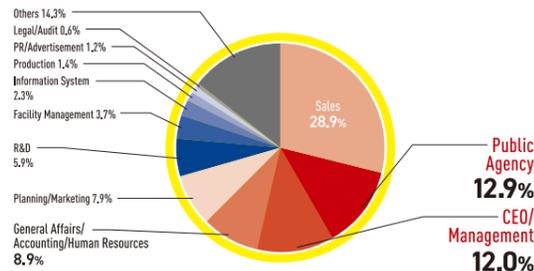

Visitor Breakdown by Industry

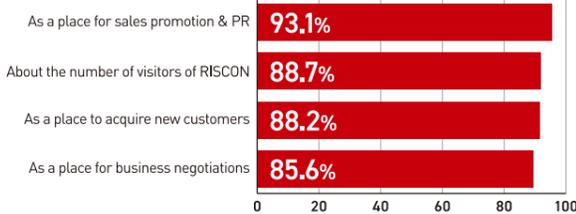


Visitor Breakdown by Job

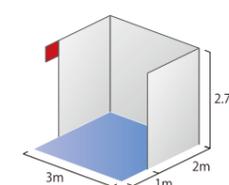
